PART 1: BEFORE YOU HIRE

WHAT EXACTLY DOES A WEDDING DJ DO?

Your wedding DJ helps create the "atmosphere" for your big day. From music, to lighting to emceeing, there are many key moments your wedding DJ is going to be responsible for. A great DJ knows how to read a crowd to keep the dance floor packed while also acting as an emcee to help the flow of the event run smoothly.

Not only are they responsible for playing great music, but they also deliver a memorable experience that you and your wedding guests will remember forever. From the moment you walk down the aisle, to the last song of the night, your wedding DJ will be there to support you on your wedding from start to finish.

During your wedding day, a DJ provides between 6 to 10 hours of total music service - including about 4 to 6 hours of nonstop music for your guests to dance to after dinner. Although we'd never suggest that your wedding DJ is the most important vendor, they are without doubt the vendor that your guests will be the exposed to the most during your big day, which means making the right choice very important.

Know that when you choose to hire a professional DJ, they will work tirelessly to ensure your wedding day is perfect.





CHAPTER 1:

MOST COMMON DJ TYPES

Not all DJs are the equal. Just as there are a variety of different makeup artists and photographers, there are a dozen or more types of DJs in the entertainment industry. When it comes to finding a provider of music for your special day, make sure that you choose a DJ who has wedding experience and who you think will be a good fit for your guests.

Below is a list of the different types of DJ you may run into while searching for the right one:

1. LOCAL DJ

Local DJs perform in your town's nightclubs, bars or restaurants. In your local bars you'll find everything from expert DJs tearing up the dancefloor to amateur DJs making their debut set. Since almost all types of DJs perform at bars and clubs at some point, there may be a huge variance in skill and ability among local DJs.

PRO:

to choose from

CON:

May not have much wedding experience.

IS IT A GOOD PICK FOR YOUR WEDDING?

In many cases yes, but check for experience and insurance/license.

2. CELEBRITY DJ

A "Celebrity DJ" is famous for producing and/or performing their own music, and remixes of other artists' music at festivals, concerts, or as the main act at a nightclub. Although we call them DJs, they are typically focused on music production, and they have a large established following of listeners.

Some examples of Celebrity DJs are;

- Tiesto
- Avicii
- David Guetta
- Deadmau5

PRO:

Highly skilled master of their craft.

CON:

Difficult to find and the most expensive option.

SHOULD I HIRE A CELEBRITY DJ FOR MY WEDDING? Yes! If you can afford it.

3. "BEDROOM" DJ

A bedroom DJ is a nickname given to DJs who are just starting out with a small setup in their bedroom where they can practice mixing.

It's a great place to start, but bedroom DJs lack many of the necessary skills required to perform well at a wedding, from choosing music for all age groups and backgrounds to troubleshooting equipment malfunctions.

PRO:

There are a lot of them.

CON:

Is probably not a dj you would want to hire.

SHOULD I HIRE A BEDROOM DJ FOR MY WEDDING?

Inexperienced DJ's are not recommended for complex events such as weddings.

4. RADIO DJ

PRO:

Skilled in multiple genres and used to remote setups

CON:

Some radio DJs don't have any wedding event experience.

SHOULD I HIRE A RADIO DJ FOR MY WEDDING?

Yes, as long as they have some wedding experience.

A radio DJ works for a local radio station and typically cues up music during live programming, reads announcements, and likely performs mixes of popular music.

Since each station typically only has one or two DJs, these jobs are highly coveted and radio DJs are often quite talented, depending on the station.

They share a lot of similarities with wedding or celebrity DJs, as they often go to events with the radio station and are used to performing at remote setups.

5. KARAOKE DJ

This is a DJ who sets up at local bars or remote booths to perform karaoke. These DJs play a backing track with a monitor that displays the lyrics so guests can sing along.

Although they are still commonly referred to as DJs, they usually do not use turntables to mix music and are quite different in range of experience. Some professional wedding DJs will offer Karaoke as a package add-on.

PRO:



CON:

We don't recommend you rely on karaoke as entertainment for the entire event.

Not unless you absolutely LOVE karaoke.



6. WEDDING DJ

A wedding DJ is an expert providing music services for weddings and travels to the event with their own equipment.

Many of the best wedding DJs have established companies and staff members that are licensed and insured to work at your event. Plus they typically offer great packages and services for weddings, corporate events, schools, proms, and private parties.

PRO:

Should have the most experience with weddings.

CON:

Can be a large array of experience and skill.

CHAPTER 2:

THE MANY ROLES OF A WEDDING DJ

DISC JOCKEY

The core tenant of being a Disc Jockey is to never let the music stop. DJs do this by playing two sources of music at the same time, while blending them together using a mixer and two turntables. Today, most DJs use digital controllers to mix music instead of vinyl turntables to play tunes that will pack the dance floor and keep your guests coming back for more.

MASTER OF CEREMONY

It's common for DJs to act as an emcee for your wedding to make announcements or help run entertainment that take place during the evening. From introducing the wedding party to encouraging your guests to get on the dancefloor, a professional wedding DJ/MC is a master at interacting with your guests in a way that leaves them feeling excited and energized.

EVENT PLANNER

Your wedding DJ will work with you to pick the music for your ceremony, cocktail hour, dinner and dancing, as well as events and games. During your wedding day, your DJ helps with the flow of these events through music cues and by making announcements. A professional wedding DJ helps the bride and groom plan and execute the wedding day timeline with class.

LIGHTING TECHNICIAN


Lighting is a critical element that will amplify the mood and ambience of your wedding day and can help make your evening photos really stand out. Wedding DJs typically supply lighting equipment and offer a variety of lighting solutions that will complement your event venue. An excellent wedding DJ will plan the distribution of lighting equipment to maximize atmospheric effects without blinding your guests.

SOUND ENGINEER

Ever been to an event where the music was far too loud to enjoy? You're not alone. A great wedding DJ must also be an expert in sound systems, how to integrate them with your venue, and how to troubleshoot when things go wrong. Your wedding DJ will need to understand electronic signals and how sound moves throughout the room to organize the sound in a way that will maximize the acoustic potential of the room.

ROADIE

Wedding DJs don't always have the luxury of hiring a "roadie" - someone to help them transport gear to and from a set location. So unless they have an assistant, they are required to lug several hundred pounds of very expensive equipment back and forth for each event.

CHAPTER 3:

THE AVERAGE COST OF A WEDDING DJ

The cost of hiring a wedding DJ can vary based on several factors including the type of Dj desired, location of your wedding venue, event date, venue size guest count as well as the variety of services or add-ons required.

On average, if you live in Canada you should expect to pay somewhere between \$800 to \$2000 for a professional DJ who is licensed, insured and has wedding experience.

In addition to supplying music to keep you and your guests entertained throughout the evening, many professional and premium DJs provide sound, lighting and emcee services plus any add-ons such as dry ice, games, photo booth or pre-wedding events.



The wedding reception DJ packages typically include all of the essentials along with a basic lighting and sound package.

How much does a DJ cost for a wedding reception only?

Hiring a DJ for a wedding reception should cost between \$800-\$1200.

This type of wedding package is by far the most popular for weddings. Couples love having the DJ there to provide music and microphones for their ceremony to ensure that the guests don't miss a moment. 

Typically your DJ will arrive in advance of the wedding, to confirm all the arrangements are in place, to reassure you that all will be perfect during your celebration.

These packages can be difficult to find as destination wedding DJ's are few and far between. If you are hosting a destination wedding we highly recommend bringing an experienced DJ with you to ensure your night goes the way you plan.

How much does a DJ cost for a destination wedding dj package?

CHAPTER 5:

WHERE TO FIND YOUR WEDDING DJ

Depending on where you live, you may be inundated with choices of wedding DJ's or having a hard time even finding a few qualified candidates. Either way, you're going to want to make a shortlist of available DJs who fit within your budget. Here are a few places that you can search to help you narrow down your selection.

YOUR DIRECT NETWORK

Friends and family should be the first place you look. Asking your friends who've been recently married for referrals is a great way to hear about a DJ from first hand experience. Posting to your Facebook page asking for wedding DJ recommendations is also a good way to get your list started.

WEDDING DIRECTORIES & BLOGS

From Wedding Wire to the Knot, wedding blogs and forums are not only a great resource to help you plan your big day, they also have directories that include vendor contact information, service overviews, ratings and more.

WEDDING FACEBOOK GROUPS

There are tons of great Facebook communities that can help you find wedding vendors, but before you go join any of those groups, you should know it's a feeding frenzy. Most posts in local Facebook groups will get 50 to 100 responses from vendors. It's a good idea to turn your phone on silent and let those responses roll in and the notifications can be a bit overwhelming for some.

WEDDING VENUE'S PREFERRED VENDORS LIST

If you're booking a DJ, ideally you should already have your venue and your date picked out. One quick call to your wedding venue should get you a list of their recommended or preferred vendors. The great part about this is your venue will likely have established relationships with vendors who do great work and already have experience doing weddings at your venue.

WEDDING VENDORS

There are an endless amount of wedding vendors for you to sort through, so one of the best ways to find a few great ones would be to ask any vendors you have already hired if they can make some recommendations. Since they may have worked with them before, they likely know which vendors are excellent to work with.

GOOGLE OR OTHER WEB SEARCH

One final method to help you dig up some qualified candidates would be to search the web for local DJ companies with great reviews. We recommend to search for companies with a minimum of 10 reviews.



CHAPTER 6:

QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR WEDDING DJ

Your wedding will be one of the biggest and most important events of your life, which is why selecting the right professional to help you and your guests have an experience you will never want to forget. But with thousands of DJs to choose from, how do you select the best one for your wedding day? It all starts with asking the right questions, so we've compiled a list of questions for you to ask each DJ during your interview.

The five most important questions to ask before hiring your wedding DJ are;

- How many weddings have you done?
- Do I get to meet my DJ?
- Do you take requests?
- Are you licensed and insured?
- Can I speak with any past couples?

Q1. HOW MANY WEDDINGS HAVE YOU DONE?

This is by far the most important question for you to know. More specifically you'll want to know how many weddings the DJ who will be assigned to your event has completed, since some DJ companies will outsource to multiple freelance DJ's. If the company has more than one DJ be sure to ask who will be your DJ and how many weddings (not years) experience they have. If the number is less than twenty or so weddings, we do not recommend proceeding unless you have been recommended the DJ by a trusted source. Most professional DJ companies will have completed hundreds of weddings with 4-5 star reviews.

Q2. DO I GET TO MEET MY DJ?

Many well established DJ companies have in-house DJ's who work exclusive with them, along with freelancers or contractors who they might call up in case they get overbooked. A great DJ company will never send out someone they have not thoroughly vetted, and you definitely get to meet your DJ before your wedding and sit down with them to discuss your event.

Q3. DO YOU TAKE SONG REQUESTS?

This may or may not be an important thing to you, but this question will say a lot about the versatility of your DJ and how willing they are to go with the flow. Naturally, it's difficult to incorporate all song requests from guests into an evening (and trust us, we've heard it all!) but not being willing to cater to the requests from guests is a sign that your DJ is not going to provide the type of experience you want for your guests.

Q4. ARE YOU LICENSED AND INSURED?

You're going to want to make sure that your DJ has taken care of licensing and insurance on their end. Although there are rarely circumstances in which license or insurance comes into play, having both is a sign of a well established DJ company.

Q5. CAN I SPEAK WITH PAST COUPLES?

Without a doubt the best way to get to know the quality or skill of a DJ is a personal recommendation from somebody who has seen them perform. If you did not hear about your DJ from friends or family who have hired them previously, you may be able to request to speak via phone or email with some past brides to give you the clearest picture of their skill level.

Q6. DO YOU EMCEE?

Having a DJ as your event emcee can be a great choice, as they can help manage the flow of an event. Being confident on the mic and knowing how to read a crowd, improvise guest interactions and make important announcements can set a great DJ apart from the rest.

Q7. DO YOU BRING BACKUP EQUIPMENT?

What happens if you have an equipment failure? A good DJ should have a backup for any point of failure. Everything from laptop, speakers, mixing console and cables begin to break down over time, so it is inevitable that a failure will happen eventually. We recommend ensuring your DJ has a fail-safe plan built into their contract before you make a deposit.

Q8. WHAT OTHER SERVICES DO YOU OFFER?

It's not uncommon for DJ's to have a variety of services available, for which you might be able to package together to save some money. From sound and lighting to photobooth, slideshows and bands, many DJ companies have more options than you might expect.

Q9. WHAT DO YOU REQUIRE FOR A DEPOSIT?

We do not recommend paying more than 50% of your event date as a deposit. In most cases your DJ will ask for between 300-600 for a standard wedding deposit, but beware of DJ Companies who as for 80-100% ahead of time, as there is some potential for scams in our industry.

Q10. DO YOU BELONG TO AN ASSOCIATION?

Belonging to a professional DJ association is a good indicator that you are dealing with a qualified professional. Many of these associations even provide license and insurance options for DJ's so you might get two for one with this question.

Q11. HOW MANY STAFF WILL YOU SEND OUT?

Knowing who will be showing up to your wedding is always important, not only for your own peace of mind but also for the caterers and other vendors. While most DJ Companies will send out one or two staff members to run your wedding, you'll want to be sure that they are not bringing in any non-staff members such as friends looking to crash a party.

Q12. DO YOU HAVE ANY PAST MIXES I CAN HEAR?

A lot of DJ's won't, and that's okay because this question is not a make or break. If your DJ has great reviews and lots of experience then you can be confident in hiring them. A live performance is often very different from a recorded mix, but if your DJ does have some mixes that they have recorded, that would be an awesome bonus for you to get to hear their mixing ability before committing.


